**SUBJECT: Missing Person Investigation – Nicholas Garza**

The Police Department had been attempting to find a male reportedly walking along Weybridge Street in Weybridge and Middlebury in the early morning hours of February 6, 2008, hours after Nicholas Garza is last known to be seen on Campus. Police investigators wanted to identify this person in order to ascertain if this person had any information relevant to the disappearance of Nicholas Garza.

The person walking along Weybridge Street was located and identified by police on March 5, and a subsequent inquiry into his activities revealed he was not a person involved in the disappearance of Nicholas Garza and that aspect of the police investigation is closed.

The investigation is continuing as information is being collected from investigators in the field and analyzed in efforts to develop any leads into the disappearance.

Ground conditions are being monitored daily. The mild weather has reduced the snow pack, but at this time conditions still preclude a ground search.
